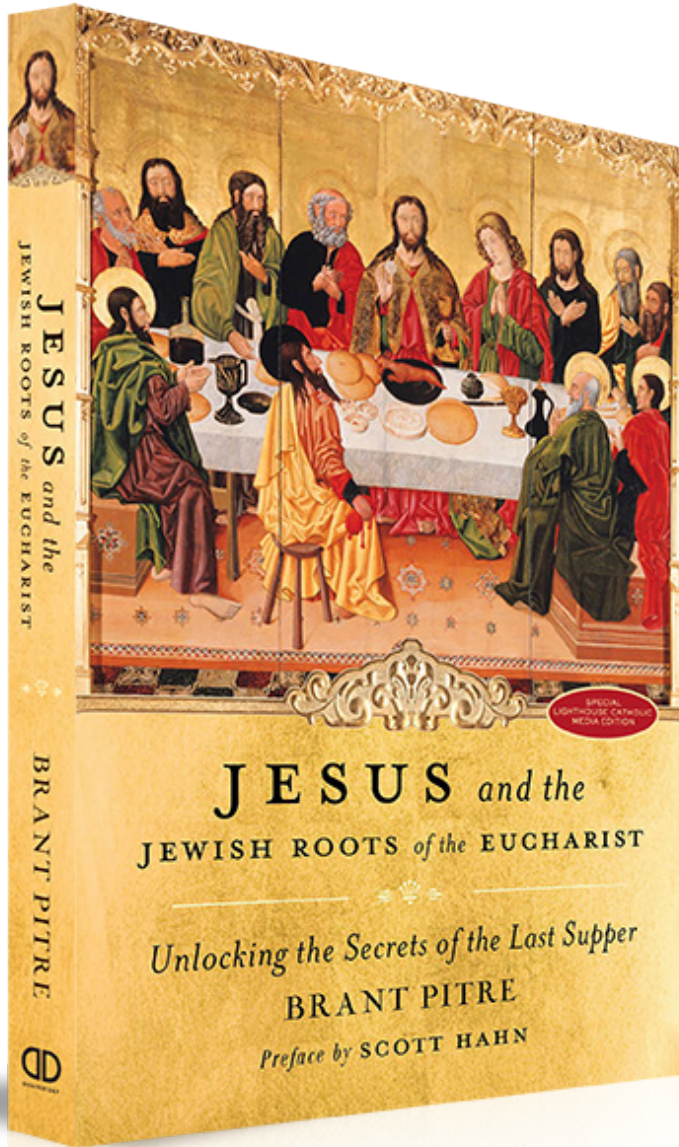

JESUS AND THE JEWISH ROOTS OF THE EUCHARIST

This book shines fresh light on the Last Supper by looking at it through Jewish eyes. Along the way, Dr. Pitre also explains how Jesus united the Last Supper to his death on Good Friday and his Resurrection on Easter Sunday.
