"After today, we will have a new CD available each weekend, so you can continue to learn more and more about our incredible Catholic Faith. These CDs will be available in the vestibule/narthex. Donations of a few dollars to offset our costs would be appreciated."

"Whether you take just the first CD, or take part every week, I want to challenge you to answer the call to share the Catholic Faith with others. Passing on a CD makes it easy. Remember, when you leave, please take a CD, and **just push play!**"
